IMPORTANT: Tuition is based on a monthly rate and not the number of classes in a month as this will vary from month to month. Students usually receive an average of 39-42 classes per season. Classes are weekly but tuition is figured monthly.

Tuition is automatically charged on the 1st of each month (August-May). A late fee of \$15.00 is charged to accounts not paid by the 10th.

A 5% discount is applied to accounts who pay for the entire year in full by September 15th, 2017. This payment is NON-REFUNDABLE.

Monthly Tuition is NOT pro-rated for missed classes. We offer make-up classes for these occasions but they must be scheduled in advance with teacher.

Tuition is non-refundable. All withdrawals must be received in writing prior to the 1st of the month in order not be charged for that month. We do not accept verbal withdraws.

We do not generate monthly invoices. We accept major credit cards on an event basis. A \$40.00 fee is charged on all returned checks.

When making a payment by cash or check, please include the first and last name / s in the memo of your check, so we may credit the proper account. We can accept cash & check payments as long as they are paid prior to the due date.

Any account unpaid after the (10th) tenth of the month, even those who auto-draft come back declined, will have late charges assessed for \$10.00 of the total monthly tuition. Any student with an overdue balance of more than 60 days will not be allowed into class until payment in full is received or payment arrangements have been made.

Credits will not be given for missed classes due to illness, inclement weather, or personal commitments. If your dancer misses class due to illness or other personal reason, they will be able to make up in a similar class up to 3 allowed per dance season.

Year End Recital Policies:

We produce a year end program at the end of the season with all dancers participating. This is an exciting and rewarding part of the season that everyone looks forward to and we encourage all dancers to participate. Recital Costume and recital fees per class to be announced. Costume payments are non-refundable. If your costume fees are not paid in full by the deadline, they will not be ordered. Any alterations needed will be the responsibility of the parent.

- All children must be accompanied by a parent / guardian at all times unless they are in class.

- Please make an effort to be prompt as this causes distractions to the other students in the class. We cannot be responsible for your child after class. Please call if you are running late and need us to keep an eye on your child.
- No parents, friends, or siblings in the class room at any time. This is for the benefit of your dancer. They will learn more if we have their complete attention.
- We do not close for teacher workdays, MLK, Pres. Day.
